Within delegated authority, the Director will be responsible for the following: • Directs and manages the work of the Division. This includes but is not limited to:

- Pursuant to requests from Member States and/or mandates from UN legislative bodies, and in consultation with relevant United Nations system entities, **conduct electoral needs assessments**, recommend the parameters for United Nations electoral assistance and **advise on the design of electoral mission** components or assistance projects; - Develop and manage the single roster of electoral experts; - Maintain the **institutional memory of the Organization** with respect to electoral matters; - Provide political and technical guidance to United Nations entities involved in electoral assistance, including on **policies and good practice**; - When required, support the USG and other UN senior officials in the **prevention and mediation of electoral crises**; - Maintain **partnerships with other regional and intergovernmental organizations** involved in elections. • Contributes to the formulation of the department's overall strategies and policies by participating in various committees, **preparing documents on policy issues**, and acting, as required, in an **advisory capacity** to the USG. Contributes to the overall management of the Department's activities and operations. • Provides **leadership to the development of innovative** and/or change management programmes • **Formulates and implements the substantive work programme of the Division** under his/her supervision, determining **priorities**, and **allocating resources for the completion of outputs and their timely delivery**. • Oversees the **management of activities** undertaken by the Division, ensuring that **programmed activities are carried out in a timely fashion** and co-ordinates work in the different areas both within the Division and Department, and with other organizations of the United Nations System, donors and agencies as appropriate. • **Co-ordinates and oversees the preparation of reports for presentation to intergovernmental bodies such as the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budget Questions**, Committee for Programme Coordination, Economic and Social Council, the General Assembly and other policy-making organs, as appropriate. • Reports to intergovernmental bodies on budget/programme performance or on **programmatic/substantive issues**, as appropriate, particularly those presented in biannual and/or annual reports. • Ensures that the **outputs produced by the Division maintain high-quality standards**; that reports are clear, objective and based on comprehensive data. Ensures that all outputs produced by the division under his/her supervision meet required standards before completion to ensure they comply with the relevant mandates. • Undertakes or oversees the programmatic/administrative tasks necessary for the functioning of the Division, including **preparation of budgets, assigning and monitoring of performance parameters and critical indicators, reporting on budget/programme performance, preparation of inputs for results-based budgeting, evaluation of staff performance (PAS), interviews of candidates for job openings and evaluation of candidates**. • Oversees the recruitment of staff for the Division taking due account geographical and gender balance and other institutional values. • **Manages, guides, develops and trains staff under his/her supervision; foster teamwork and communication among staff in the Division and across organizational boundaries**. • Chairs meetings, seminars, etc., on substantive-related issues; **represents the Organization at international, regional, inter-agency meetings, seminars and conference**; provides **programmatic/substantive expertise on an issue, or holds programmatic/substantive and organizational discussions with representatives of other institutions**. • Perform other related duties as requested by the senior management of the Organization. • **Follows political, security and other developments in various countries in order to give early warning of tensions and potential conflicts in support of the Secretary-General's responsibilities in the maintenance of international peace and security.**

QUESTIONNAIRE



1. Over fifteen years of progressively responsible experience in electoral administration or assistance, international political issues, human resources management, administration, logistics, financial management, budget or related field is required. Please explain how you meet this criterion using examples.

As per my childhood dream, I worked and studied all around the world to learn culture and languages. I wrote travel books, an Encyclopedia about art and symbols, and studied International Negotiations.

At the Alliance française of Bahrain, I collaborated with Embassies and local institutions to promote France in the Middle-East. We established quarterly calendars with the budget allotted by the SCAC and the profits from our classes. I organized the events, redacted financial reports and also managed the examination center.

Most recently, simultaneously to teaching at Idea School, I built my art (and now political) business online, participating actively to the Presidential elections, promoting and recommending candidates, sharing strategies and connecting partners. This instant access to the news highlighted the urgency of collaborating as branches of one tree to counter corruption and terrorism and ensure a viable and thriving future.

2. A minimum of ten years of relevant electoral experience in a multilateral setting is required. Please explain how you meet this criterion using examples.

In a world where technology is exponentially soaring and AI will revolutionize our lives, we don't have time to stop at details. Years are seconds! I have never cared to vote in my life, until a man came to tell women what they should do with their own body. 2024 was my first time voting, but I got involved into the elections like my life depends on it. Because it does. Pollution is damaging our lungs, and wars are raging. The new Secretary-General of NATO just declared that more funds will be spent on armament within the next five years, and our taxes are vanishing in nuclear smokes. I have been at the frontline of "relevant electoral" experience since I was born a world citizen. Period. Seriously, I was born in France, in May 1986, one month after the Tchernobyl explosion. Going on a nuclear hunt and converting the power plants to solar is somethin' personal. America needs a solid bridge with Europe. I am also marching for the NOMINATION of SG Guterres for the Nobel Peace Prize!

3. Managerial experience, including management of large diverse teams, is required. Please explain how you meet this criterion using examples.

Working at the Alliance française as a Cultural Director, I managed a team of ten teachers of all backgrounds to implement our quarterly cultural calendar. Our large audience also was of all cultures and faiths. As a teacher, I use different approaches to captivate my students, using countdowns or hand signals, music to relax or creative team-building activities as ice-breakers.

I believe a great manager turns her qualities to her advantage and delegates the load of work efficiently by knowing her team members and their strengths, offering everyone an opportunity to shine. Give the creative work to artists and administrative tasks to the most organized. Management is the balance between remaining calm to solve problems, leading with integrity and demanding accountability.

Teenagers taught me to deliver results and joy for learning while enforcing discipline. Raising citizens who respect the rules, and heroes going beyond the limitations. I also just completed a Human Rights training.

4. Experience in preventive diplomacy, peacemaking and/or peacekeeping is required. Please explain how you meet this criterion using examples.

For a decade, I have been publishing cultural and political content on my website, social media platforms and at the schools where I worked, to support diversity, equity, and facilitate the integration of new immigrants. Mentorship and the exposure to different perspectives are key to preventive diplomacy.

Since 90% of the public information is now digital, we communicate instantly. This way, I have reached a worldwide network among NATO, NASA, Space X, The White House, the UN, the FBI, journalists from Russia, European Presidents and Representatives, contributing guidelines and advice. The result is an innovative collaboration towards peace and security.

To avoid a climatic and humanitarian catastrophe, my goal is to redirect warfare towards the Space Olympics 2030, and to convert rockets into sustainable spaceships. I sent art, equations, letters, emails, crystals, to catch the attention of our leaders even though I was still an outsider. Give me a badge and the game is on!

5. Experience working in or on conflict or post-conflict settings is required. Please explain how you meet this criterion using examples.

My divorce was the toughest conflict in my life, having to co-parent, build my art business and live under the same roof for two years despite tensions. Similarly to what is happening in Israel. I was bullied by terrorists and my family never believed me. I had to rebuild my reputation and network with no funds, and surround myself with mentors.

What helped me was understanding the different stages of acceptance: from ignorance to denial, then questioning, negotiating, acceptance and, finally, resolution. In this particular case, I knew that negotiating during the anger stage was not possible, and had to wait for favorable conditions to discuss the best outcome for our child.

For Israel, the anger will never be gone. Souls are marked forever. Solidarity is essential, but finding and eliminating the source of terrorism is indispensable. We must separate opponents with a two-states policy, provide cultural education (not weapons) for the new generations, and ensure mutual acceptance.




